Minutes approved from last years meeting.

Onion River Soccer Club- Colleen reported on prior conversation with Brian Clark, this years usage of soccer field to remain consistent with last years usage.

Baseball clean up- Uncertain if Worcester will have a little league this year. Ted agreed to contact Mark(little league organizer) to check if a team has formed and clean up needed.

Basketball court- Looking ahead to possible maintenance, Michele will get a quote for fixing of crack and resurfacing.

It was agreed to recommend to the selectboard that Dot Davy and Jessie Lacombe will, weather providing, hay the haymeadow by the 3<sup>rd</sup> week in june. If this is not possible they will brushhog it by the 4<sup>th</sup> of july for \$200.

The committee suggested the possibility of revitalizing the haymeadow with proper nutrients and seed. Colleen agreed to get Dot Davy figures on exact acreage so she could look into the cost of spreading potash or pellet fertilizer. Colleen agreed to contact UVM to check on soil testing.
