Road Maintenance Update -

- Audra Brown applied for a change in driveway access on Hampshire Hill. Does not affect 911

- Brian applied for and received a grant for \$6600 from the Central VT Regional Planning Commission. Majority of funds will be used for maintenance on Minister Brook Rd.
- Brian is getting estimates for repairing culverts on Minister Brook Rd.

Fire Department Review –

- New airpacks arrived and are on the trucks.
- Brian will help with the install of a dry hydrant at 115 Norton Rd. in September.
- Will is unhappy with the lighting work that was done. He is trying to coordinate with the
 company to do a walk through. He has not yet paid the invoice. Office space not done in the
 retrofit and none of the reflectors were cleaned. Additionally, no diffusers were put on the
 lighting.

Old Business:

127 Norton Rd – Ted did some research as the Town Health Officer. Camper either needs to be moved off periodically to dump waste or else needs a state permit to park permanently. Would also need a waste disposal plan.
