Groups that will need to petition for funding include the American Red Cross, TW Wood Gallery, MSAC, and Kellogg Hubbard Library.

Note, if it is true that CVHHH is already participating in a joint petition with MSAC, the decision to approve their \$2,000 request will be revoked from our recommendation to the Select Board.

6. Discuss information transmission to select board:

7. Discuss further activity by committee:

Bill will once again prepare materials to be included in the town report.
