1) Land Parcel Discussion/ Kyle Devitt Property

The Commission cannot proceed until Kyle is able to secure the services of his surveyor who will, hopefully, assure us that the land can be used for the intended purpose, a “green burial” section to our cemetery.

We also will ask Kyle to compile a list of his specific requests as to his wishes for the property should we choose to accept the gift of the land.

NOTE: We can assure no one of guaranteed work on or around the property as a result of this gift. Presently, all cemetery maintenance is contracted and all earth moving ventures would be subject to open bid, as is standard procedure.

2) Business: Review of Joe Mangan’s contract with the Commission.

3) Terry Solomon: Livescape Design Proposal.

The Commission reviewed Terry’s itemized proposal and then discussed specifics as to the timing of the planting of the trees and the flowers.

Cost for sugar maples: \$860.00/ cost for wildflower seeding and planting:\$500.00. Terry has also been asked to give us an estimate for the prep work needed before planting.

If the proposals are accepted,these plantings will be two, separate jobs and will occur in the spring when Terry can schedule us.
