Section 1. No vehicles shall be parked within the graveled or paved fortion of any town highway during the winter period (November 15 through April 15) of each year.

Section 2. Any vehicle found to be parked on autown highway in violation of Section 1 above shall be subject to removal from the town highway at the owner's expense.

Section 3. Any prior ordinance of the Town of Worcester which is inconsistent with the provisions of this ordinance is hereby expressly repealed.

This ordinance shall be entered in the minutes of the town records and shall be posted in at least five conspicuous places within town. It shall be published in either the World or the Times Argus within fourteen days of its adoption. It shall become effective sixty days after its adoption unless a petition for a vote on the question of disapproving the ordinance is signed by at least five percent of the qualified voters of the Town of Worcester and presented to the Selectmen or the Town Clerk within forty-four days after adoption of the ordinance. If such a petition is received, the Selectmen will call a special town meeting, and the ordinance will become effective at the end of that meeting unless a majority of the qualified voters voting on the question at the meeting vote to disapprove the ordinance.
