Fire Department –

Will reported that things have been relatively quiet as of late. Truck repairs to pumps will be covered by warranty. He requested that Mountainview Security be contacted for training on new monitoring system. Mutual Aid is working with Central Vermont Regional Planning Commission to explore the possibility of merging dispatch centers. Will is keeping the Selectboard advised on any changes. The FCC has approved a new frequency channel through Capitol Aid. This will greatly improve communication.

Katie presented a report that 4 out of 5 delinquent tax payers have signed her letters of agreement. Cheri motioned to follow the Delinquent Tax Policy and send the non-compliant tax payers to the town lawyer if they haven't responded by 02/04/2019. Ted seconded. Motion passed

Katie reports a good amount of interest in the Town Service Committee. The Selectboard will formally recognize this group at the reorganization meeting after Town Meeting.

Bills were approved and signed.
